Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to release some terminal benefits.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case, representation dated 15.01.2021 (P-2) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that she is not averse to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with

direction to respondent No.3-Director General of Police, Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 15.01.2021 (P-2), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
