The petitioners pray for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the official respondents to take action against respondent no.8 (the builder)

Pursuant to the supply of an advance copy of the writ petition, Mr. Samarth Sagar, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, entered appearance. On 25.2.2022, he had admitted that despite various reports against respondent No.8, no action has been taken by the official respondents. Hence, he was requested to take complete instructions.

Today, Sh. Sagar, on instructions from Mr. Ashwini Mehra, Junior Engineer, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram, has stated that the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram, is seized of the matter and on the request of the Residents Welfare Association, the matter has been kept for next week. He assured the Court that by the end of the next week, some effective order shall be passed.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file an application for revival, if the grievance still persists.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
