The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.120 dated 04.11.2019, registered under Sections 379-B and 34 IPC at Police Station Division No.2, District Jalandhar.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the petition qua petitioner No.2-Jeeto Kaur alias Krishna.

Permitted to do so.

Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.2-Jeeto Kaur alias Krishna.
