By this common order, the petition(s), the details of which have
been given in the headings are being disposed of.

These petitions are filed for seeking regular bail in case FIR
No.565 dated 23.12.2020 under Sections 15 and 25 of NDPS Act, 1985
registered at Police Station Indri, District Karnal.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Ganga Ram Punia, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Karnal on behalf of State in CRM-M-39373-2022 and the same is taken on record.

One of the main ground for seeking regular bail is the custody period and the fact that the trial is not proceeding at a decent pace. However, as per the reply filed, all the prosecution witnesses have been examined.

In view of reply filed, no case is made out for granting regular bail and the petitions are disposed of at this stage.

However, there is no doubt that in case a request is made before the Court concerned, by the petitioners for an expeditious disposal of the trial, the same would be considered, in accordance with law.
