In a civil suit for grant of permanent injunction filed by respondent No.2 ex parte judgment and decree dated 17.12.2015 has been passed in favour of the plaintiff. Aggrieved, the petitioners have filed an application under Order 9 Rule 13 read with Section 151 CPC for setting aside the ex parte judgment and decree. This application is pending adjudication.

The present writ petition has been filed for quashing of the aforementioned judgment and decree on the ground that title of the petitioners to the land in dispute has been decided in their favour upto the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

Since, an application under Order 9 Rule 13 read with Section 151 CPC is pending adjudication, the filing of this writ petition is an abuse of process of law. It is accordingly dismissed.
