The petitioners herein are seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to promote them to the post of Head Constable.

At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners would submit that at the present moment, the petitioners would be satisfied in case their legal notice dated 09.09.2022, Annexure P-9, served upon respondent No.2, which has not been decided till date, is decided in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Deepali Puri, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let sufficient number of copies of complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide legal notice dated 09.09.2022 (Annexure P-9) of the petitioners, within a period of two months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioners. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
