Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to carry out fair and transparent investigation in FIR No.272 dated 5.12.2021, registered under Sections 307, 365, 323, 447, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act and in cross DDR No.42 dated 7.12.2021 under Sections 452, 354, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Tanda.

Vide order dated 31.1.2022, the State was directed to file status report. In pursuance to the same, status report by way of affidavit of Raj Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Tanda, District Hoshiarpur filed in Court is taken on record.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and from the instructions received from ASI Rajesh Kumar, who is present in Court, it has been brought to the notice of the Court that in all there were 6 accused in the present FIR, however, now investigation is complete and challan has been

presented against two of the accused, namely Karanvir Singh and Simarnjit Kaur. Karanvir Singh is none other than the petitioner in the present petition.

In view of the attending position and without commenting on the merits of the case, this Court finds it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with liberty to the parties to avail their remedies as available to them before the learned trial Court.
