CRM No.15664 of 2022:

This application has been filed praying for addition of subsequently added Sections 354 and 34 IPC in the main petition and also for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the subsequently added sections.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of this petition, the prosecution has added offences under Section 354 and 34 IPC.

Notice in the application.

Learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.

The FIR and the petition be read along with the subsequently added offences.

Main Case:

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.189, dated

30.10.2021, under Sections 406, 498A IPC (Sections 354 and 34 IPC added today vide CRM No. 15664 of 2022), registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim direction granted vide order dated 17.3.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Sahib Singh, has not disputed the fact regarding petitioner's joining the investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 17.3.2022 is made absolute.
