In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that they are teaching the students of Commerce, whereas the workload of the Commerce stream is being withdrawn from them to be taught by the other teachers.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the meeting of the respondent-University held on 06.08.2022, a decision was taken that except the languages, the other subjects of the B.com students will be taught by the teachers, who are working in the department of Commerce, which resolution needs to be given effect to as the petitioners apprehend that by withdrawing the workload from the petitioners, their services will be terminated in the near future by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondent-University submits that in case petitioners have any grievance with regard to the non-compliance of the resolution dated 06.08.2022, they can raise the said grievance before the authorities concerned of the University by way of filing an appropriate representation, which will be decided by the respondent-University in accordance with law coupled with the resolution of the withdrawal of workload as already passed and the petitioners will be informed about the outcome of the said representation within a period of 08 weeks after the same is taken.

Learned counsel for the respondents undertakes that till the said decision is taken, no adverse action will be taken against the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, present writ petition may be disposed off having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents for redressal of their grievance.

Ordered accordingly.
