Status-report on behalf of the respondent-State (by way of the affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Civil Lines, Ludhiana), as forwarded by learned State counsel to the Court through *email*, is taken on the record.

However, after arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, while submitting that the petitioner would be surrendering before the concerned trial Court within one week and would be moving an application there for seeking regular bail and he further prays that the trial Court be directed to decide his bail application within some specific time frame.

Learned State counsel has no objection to the above-

discussed submission as well as the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the concerned Court below within the period of one week and moves any application there for seeking the relief of regular bail, the same be decided within three days positively.
