It being well past 4:00 p.m., none appears for the petitioner, though a report has received from the learned trial court dated 18.04.2022, stating to the effect that all prosecution witnesses stand examined with the prosecution having closed its evidence and with the statement of the accused also having been recorded under Section 313 Cr.P.C..

Thus, only witnesses for the accused remain to be examined, with the next date of hearing also having gone by today, i.e. it was yesterday.

In view of the above, at this stage I would see no cause to admit the petitioner to bail and though it is past 4:00 p.m. and counsel for the petitioner is not present, this petition is dismissed.

If however, the trial still does not conclude within a reasonable period due to no fault of the petitioner or his counsel, he would be at liberty to file a similar petition afresh.
