

- (i) *that the petitioner shall make herself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) *that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- (iii) *that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court”*

Upon instructions from ASI Harmesh Kumar, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the aforesaid orders, the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 17.12.2021 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
