The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that for her grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 10.12.2021 (Annexure P-2) to the Superintendent of Police, District Panipat i.e. respondent No.2 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. The petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kuldeep Tiwari, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Panipat, to take a decision on the representation dated 10.12.2021 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and grant her protection, if any threat to her life and liberty is perceived, in accordance with law.
