1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of orders, Annexure P/1 and P/2, dated 25.04.2022, in CWP-8402-2022.

2. At the outset, DAG, Haryana, has placed on record copy of order dated 15.11.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 03.03.2022, filed by him pursuant to order Annexure P/1 and P/2. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 15.11.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

3. In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
