AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents (arrayed in the petition), as they have solemnised marriage against the wishes of their parents.

Learned counsel for the State appearing on advance notice submits that statement of the girl has been recorded wherein she has stated that her parents and relatives are not happy with the marriage but has not stated anything about threat perception.

In view of the above, no further directions are called for.

The petition is disposed of.

There is no doubt that in eventuality of petitioners approaching the police authorities, the needful in accordance with law would be done expeditiously.

It is clarified that this court has not commented upon the factum of marriage; validity of marriage of the petitioners, their age as aadhaar card is not the proof of date of birth.
