ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the previous order dated 20.12.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
2. The above said fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel on instructions received from the concerned police station. However, learned State counsel has opposed the bail and submits that in case this Court is inclined to give the bail to the petitioner then it should be subject to the strict and stringent conditions.
3. Given the nature of allegations, no pre-trial incarceration is required. Without commenting on the case's merits and the circumstances peculiar to this case, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
4. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 15.12.2021, is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall file an affidavit regarding his financial particulars i.e. bank accounts held

individually/jointly,DEMAT accounts, total value of sovereign in possession and cash in hand. Failure to do so, complainant as well as State are at liberty to file an application for cancellation of bail.
