1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 06.08.2021, in CWP-14099-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1, reveals that CWP-14099-2021 was disposed of by directing the respondents to treat CWP-14099-2021 as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within one month.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, refers to reply as also order Annexures R/1 to R/5 attached thereto and states that in view of speaking order Annexure R/5 dated 03.12.2021 having been passed by respondent No.1 deciding the claim of the petitioner, no action is called for under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 against the respondents.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of speaking order Annexure R/5 dated 03.12.2021 having been passed by respondent No.1, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant

Annexure R-5 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure R-5 dated 03.12.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
