Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned notice dated 26.07.2019 (Annexure P-1) vide which recovery of Rs.16,56,047/- is directed to be made effected from petitioner, calculated on the basis of performance sheet for the financial year

2011-12 to 2017-18 wrongly and illegally at the time of retirement of petitioner without adhering to rules and regulations just to harass the petitioner and further issue a writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to release all the retiral benefits to the petitioner.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the representation dated 20.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
