MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioners have approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.455 dated 26.10.2021 under Sections 379 and 506 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sadar Nuh, District Nuh, who apprehends their arrest at the hands of Police.

On 20.12.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“This is a petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.455, dated 26.10.2021, registered under Sections 379, 506 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Nuh, District Nuh.

It is argued that the petitioners were not arrested from the spot. They came to be nominated as accused on the disclosure statement. They are ready to join investigation.

Notice of motion for 11.05.2022.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join investigation within a period of one week and on their doing so, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join the

investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioners associated themselves in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by SI Anoop Singh states that indeed the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 20.12.2021 is made absolute.
