Complaining wilful defiance of the directions issued while deciding CWP-11778-2022, the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt Courts Act, 1971, has been filed.

The operative part of the directions read as under:-

“Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and without going into merits of the claim as raised by the petitioner in the present case as well as in the legal notice dated 12.04.2022 (Annexure P-7), this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the legal notice dated 12.04.2022 (Annexure P-7), filed by the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.”

It is evident that the Court had only directed respondent No.2 to pass the appropriate speaking order on the legal notice dated 12.04.2022 sent by the petitioner.

This Bench has heard the learned counsel representing the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Chopra, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts

notice on behalf of the State.

At the most, the petitioner's complaint is that respondent has failed to pass a speaking order as directed by the High Court.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of by once again requesting the respondent to pass speaking order, if not already passed, within a period of four weeks from today, positively.

If the order is not complied with, the petitioner shall have liberty to file an application for revival of the petition.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
