MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU. J.

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter-alia*, for directing the respondents to release entire amount deposited by petitioners towards contributory Provident Fund along with interest @ 8.1% per annum.

Learned Counsel, on instructions from petitioners, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits at this stage, his clients would be satisfied in case legal notice dated 20.07.2022 (P-7) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, DAG, Punjab, present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Director, Health Services and Family Welfare, Punjab, Chandigarh to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice in accordance with

law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioners would be at liberty to move appropriate application(s) for revival of this writ petition.
