The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.270 dated 04.08.2021, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 56, Gurugram and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
