On 11.03.2022, the following order was passed:-

“The learned counsel representing respondent no.1 prays for a short adjournment.

The petitioners claim to be the residents of the area. It is their case that respondent no.1 along with the petitioners converted a piece of land into a colony while dedicating certain part thereof as passages.

The learned counsel representing the petitioners contends that under the garb of decree passed, the passage to the respective houses of the petitioners is being blocked.

In this revision petition, the State of Haryana is also a party.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar, is requested to depute a responsible officer to visit the site and report about the factual position of the disputed place.

Shri Harsh Vardhan, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, has been requested to convey the order of the Court to the Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar.

Let report be submitted within a period of one month, from today.

Adjourned to 13.07.2022.”

The Deputy Commissioner has submitted a report alongwith

an inspection map. It has been pointed out that while carving out the

plots, respondent no.1 had assigned certain space for the streets. However, the aforesaid streets were connecting the old road. However, now a new road has been constructed at some distance.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel representing respondent no.1 has conceded that he will connect both the streets with the PWD new road in order to provide passage to the plot holders.

In view of the aforesaid facts, no further order is required to be passed. Respondent no.1 shall remain bound by his statement.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
