This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.56 dated 22.06.2018 under Sections 323, 341, 506 IPC (Section 201 IPC added lateron) registered at Police Station Bhandson, District Patiala and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
