Challenge in the present appeal is to the order of the learned
Single Judge dated 08.11.2016 passed in **CWP-16543-2016** filed by the
writ petitioner (respondent No.2 herein).

Directions had been given vide the impugned order to the
employer (appellant herein) to complete the inquiry proceedings and pass
final order within a period of 04 months from the said date. Further
direction had also been issued to the Punjab State Power Corporation
Limited to extend the joining period of the petitioner to the post of
Assistant Manager (HR) for a further period of 04 months as a special case.

The prayer, as such, was on account of the fact that the petitioner wanted to

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be selected and appointed to the post of Assistant Manager (HR) with the Power Corporation.

Counsel for the writ petitioner has pointed out that the petitioner is no longer interested in pursuing this litigation as he has earned a promotion with the appellant-Corporation, and now, he has become a Warehousing Manager. It is further submitted that on account of the stay in the connected matter, the inquiry proceedings could not be completed.

Keeping in view the above statement, this Court is of the opinion that the litigation as such, has become infructuous over a period of time, since the writ petitioner himself is not interested in pursuing his case.

Accordingly, the present appeal is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous in view of the above statement made by the counsel for the writ petitioner.

All pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
