1. This petition was filed for setting aside the order dated 16th September, 2019, passed by learned Judge Special Court, Ludhiana in case of FIR No. 0220, dated 26th December, 2017, under Sections 18/61 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, whereby the petitioner was declared as 'proclaimed offender'.

2. On 20th December, 2021, following order was passed:-

“The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of order dated 16.09.2019 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Judge Special Court, Ludhiana in case FIR No.0220 dated 26.12.2017, registered under Sections 18, 61 and 85 of NDPS Act, 1985, whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before learned trial Court and file application for regular bail.

However, the petitioner is directed to surrender before learned trial Court on 06.01.2022 and move fresh application for grant of regular bail, which will be decided by the trial Court expeditiously in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above, the petition is dismissed.
