Prayer in the instant application is for placing on record order dated 22.04.2021 as Annexure P-3 in pursuant to the last order dated 03.02.2022 and further for grant of exemption from filing the certified copy of the same.

Application is allowed and Annexure P-3 is taken on record.

CRM-M-53053-2021 (O&M)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.270 dated 14.12.2020, registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

In pursuant to the last order dated 03.02.2022, learned counsel has placed on record the order dated 22.04.2021 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridkot, vide which the main accused-Komal has been granted bail.

In view of the aforesaid fact that the main accused-Komal has already been granted bail by learned Sessions Court and also considering the fact that no specific role has been attributed to the present petitioners, the present petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation and in the event of arrest, petitioners shall be released on pre-arrest bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the following conditions, as envisaged under section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- (i) *that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) *that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- (iii) *that the petitioners shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.*
