Learned counsel appearing for HPSC has received instructions, according to which the revised result relating to the candidates belonging to the dependents of the freedom fighters has been declared yesterday. This is, on the basis that 2% of the vacancies, which would fall in the category of the ex-servicemen and the backward class out of the total would come to 0.88, which, when rounded off, come to one post. This calculation has been made as the total number of vacancies for the backward class as well as ex-servicemen are 44. Counsel has further informed that petitioner –

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Kawaljit Kaur has made it to the list of the successful candidates belonging to the dependents of the freedom fighters and therefore, qua her, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioner states that in the light of the above recorded statement of the counsel for the HPSC, the present writ petition may be disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to submit her application for participating in the main examination, which is fixed from 15th to 19 April, 2022.

In the light of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
