Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR but the petitioner does not want to press the said prayer, at this stage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that even the investigation is not being conducted in a manner as required under law as the Investigating Officer is behaving in a manner, which has given the impression that he is biased. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he intends to bring the said fact to the notice of the higher authorities of the Investigating Officer by filing a representation for appropriate redressal of his grievance.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Atul Yadav, Advocate, who has also joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case petitioner files any representation raising any grievance before any authority, the same will be decided expeditiously by passing an appropriate speaking order on the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of the learned State counsel, the petitioner may kindly be allowed to withdraw this petition, at this stage, with liberty to approach the Investigating Agency by filing a representation raising the grievance which the petitioner has, in respect of the conduct of the investigation upto now.
