Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.266 dated 23.10.2017, registered for offences under Sections 354 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station “E” Division Amritsar, District Amritsar, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

Report has been received from the Trial Court pursuant to order passed by this Court.

Keeping in view the nature of allegations levelled against the petitioner, who is alleged to have repeatedly harassed the complainant, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer made in the petition.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to take all the available pleas at an appropriate stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
