The matter was listed before Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 22.03.2022 and there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Today, there is no change in the situation.

The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is seeking directions to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action against private respondents upon the representation dated 24.12.2020 and 08.10.2021.

Learned State counsel has filed status report dated 07.04.2022 disclosing that petitioner had handed over two cheques to respondents who had presented for encashment. The cheques have been dishonored and respondents have filed complaint under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. The petitioner was called upon to join inquiry and in the inquiry it was found that there is financial dispute between petitioner and respondent. The petitioner had issued cheques and there is no truth in the allegations of the petitioner.

In view of the status report filed by learned State counsel no further order is warranted.
