Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.0002 dated 02.01.2021, registered for offences under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Women, District Ludhiana, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 02.08.2021, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

Despite two opportunities granted by this Court, the parties failed to appear before the Trial Court for recording of their statements.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to approach the Court again in case there is any fresh settlement between the parties.
