**HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)**

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that as per the criteria fixed for the selection to the post of TGT English as advertised vide advertisement No. 9 of 2015, in case a candidate has an experience, he/she has to be granted marks for the same, no marks have been given to the petitioner for the experience certificate, which the petitioner had appended along with the application form, which fact is clear from the result Annexure P-4 itself.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that non-grant of the marks on account of the experience, has caused prejudice to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner before the Commission vide representation dated 10.05.2022

(Annexure P-12) and thereafter, once again vide representation dated 16.10.2022 (Annexure P-13), which representations are still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representations by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 10.05.2022 (Annexure P-12) and representation dated 16.10.2022 (Annexure P-13) respectively in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 10.05.2022 (Annexure P-12) and representation dated 16.10.2022 (Annexure P-13) respectively, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 10.05.2022 (Annexure P-12) and representation dated 16.10.2022 (Annexure P-13) respectively within a period of four weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
