**ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)**

This common order shall dispose of above mentioned two petitions as they arise out of the same FIR.

Prayer in the first petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner Sukhjinder Singh in case FIR No. 6 dated 25.02.2022, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A of the IPC at Police Station Women Patiala, District Patiala, whereas the prayer in the second petition is for quashing of the said FIR on the basis of the compromise entered into between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance to order dated 06.04.2022 passed in the first petition, petitioner Sukhjinder Singh has already joined investigation and the matter stands amicably settled between the parties. It is further submitted that petitioner Sukhjinder Singh along with others have filed the second petition seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of the said compromise.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that on 04.08.2022, a cancellation report was prepared, which has been accepted by the Illaqua Magistrate on 12.11.2022, therefore, the FIR in question does not exist as on today.

In view of the same, both the petitions are disposed of and the order dated 06.04.2022, granting concession of interim bail to petitioner Sukhjinder Singh, is made absolute.
