[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the decision of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in 'Kanwar Singh SainiversusHigh Court of Delhi, 2011(4) Civil Cases, 294', he does not press the instant petition but prays for permission to withdraw the same with liberty to take out appropriate proceedings before the learned trial Court in accordance with law.

[2] In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *dismissed as withdrawn*, with the liberty as prayed for.

[3] Needless to mention, in case, any proceedings qua the grievance which is the subject matter of the instant petition are initiated before the learned trial Court, the learned trial Court is requested to consider and decide the same in accordance with law, as expeditiously.
