1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 18.08.2022, in CWP-4923-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-4923-2022, was disposed of vide order dated 18.08.2022, by directing the respondent to take an administrative decision within 30 days and in case the petitioner was found entitled to the relief claim, to grant the benefits of the same to the petitioner, within 30 days thereafter.

3. Learned State counsel has produced copy of communication dated 15.09.2022, as per which, the petitioner has secured '61' marks and on the basis of overall performance as per criteria applicable, falls in the selection zone, hence selected at merit No.13-A in EWS category for the post of Draftsman (civil), against Advt. No.14/2019, Category No.30. Learned State counsel contends that in view of needful having been done, no further action is called for against the respondent.

4. None is present on behalf of the petitioner. However, in view of needful as was required to be done in terms of order Annexure P/1, having been done, no useful purpose would be served by adjourning the matter.

5. In view of the position noted above as also in view of the fact that name of the petitioner has been recommended to the Chief Engineer, Panchayati Raj, Public Works Haryana, Chandigarh, as a selected candidate, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is called for against the respondent. The contempt petition is disposed of accordingly. However, in the eventuality of follow-up action not being taken by the concerned department in terms of the recommendation, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for taking out proceedings in accordance with law to secure compliance of order Annexure P/1 dated 18.08.2022 in CWP-4923-2022.
