The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to the respondent No.2 and 3 to take stern/strict legal action against the accused persons specifically named in case FIR No.118 dated 19.05.2022 under Sections 148, 149, 285, 323 and 506 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bichhore, District Nuh (Mewat) (Annexure P-1).

In pursuance to the order dated 14.11.2022, a status report has been filed. In the said status report it has been stated as under:-

“That the petitioner has filed the present petition under section 482 of Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to the respondent no. 2 and 3 to take stern/strict legal action against the accused persons specifically named in case FIR No. 118 dated 19.05.2022 u/s 148/149/285/323/506 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station, Bichhor, District Nuh to arrest them, which is wrong and unsustainable in view of the facts that during the course of investigation, the allegations levelled by the petitioner were not substantiated by any

cogent and reliable evidence and same were found to be incorrect. Therefore, in view of the deficient evidence in the present case, a cancellation report has been prepared on 07.10.2022 and same has been sent to the higher police authority for further legal course of action in the matter and submission of the said cancellation report to the Ld. Illaqa Magistrate, Ferozepur Jhirka.”

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail his other legal remedies as available under the law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
