Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in a meeting of the General Council of Haryana School Shiksha Pariyojna Parishad, Panchkula held on 19.12.2017, certain decision were taken under Item No. 7.18 but the same have not been given effect to by the respondents, which act of the respondent-Parishad is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before respondent No. 3-State Project Director, Haryana School Shiksha Pariyojna Parishad, Panchkula by filing a representation dated 30.09.2022 (Annexure P-16), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 3 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 30.09.2022 (Annexure P-16) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the representation, respondent No. 3 is directed to decide the representation dated 30.09.2022 (Annexure P-16), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
