In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner is entitled for the grant of child care leave so as to take care of her minor daughter, who is studying in Rajasthan and requires due care and assistance of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already taken permission from the school concerned where the minor daughter of the petitioner is studying at present that she will be allowed to leave the hostel premises and will be allowed to live with the petitioner,

hence, the respondents be directed to accept the child care leave application

of the petitioner, which is kept pending by the respondents.
