Case taken up through video conferencing.

Petitioner Sushil Sharma seeking appointment on compassionate ground on account of death of his father Rakesh Kumar working with Sarva Haryana Gramin Bank, District Palwal as Office Attendant while in service, has brought the instant civil writ petition.

Admittedly, the petitioner had not submitted any representation to the respondents before filing of the present writ petition.

Under the circumstances, in order to enable the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner and to avoid unnecessary litigation, the present writ petition is disposed of with the observations that on petitioner's submitting a detailed representation to respondents No.1 and 2 within a period of 03 weeks from today, the same be disposed of by passing a detailed speaking order in terms of rules, regulations and instructions on the subject, within a further period of 02 months thereof.

A copy of the order be sent to the petitioner as per registered AD post.

It is observed that in case the petitioner still feels dissatisfied after disposal of his representation, then he may take recourse to the legal remedy in accordance with law.
