1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 in CRWP-7146-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that prayer in CRWP-7146-2022 was for the issuance of a writ of habeas corpus for release of petitioner's daughter namely Rehana. The aforementioned writ petition was allowed by directing the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to make immediate arrangements to send the petitioner and two police officials, without delay, to the place of residence of the child and the concerned Superintendent of Police, in whose jurisdiction the child was kept, was directed to provide adequate security and police force to take custody of the child from respondent No.4/father-Syed Imamul Hossain and to hand over the same to the petitioner while respondent No.4 herein was directed to cooperate in returning the child and not create any obstruction in the same.

3. Pursuant to notice issued by this Court on 27.10.2022, compliance report was filed on 30.11.2022. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of active intervention of the police authorities, custody of the child namely Rehana has been handed over to the petitioner, after getting the child from respondent No.4 herein and that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition.

4. In view of position noted above as well as needful having been done in compliance of order Annexure P/1 dated 16.9.2022 and custody of the child having been handed over to the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
