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**SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)**

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0260 dated 11.11.2021, registered under Sections 379-B, 511, 427, 323, 341, 148 and 149 IPC at P.S. Division No.3, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 10.01.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and the operative part of the said order is reproduced hereunder:-

*“Adjourned to 22.03.2022.*

*In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so. In the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail by the arresting officer/investigating officer on furnishing of bail bonds by him to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/investigating officer.*

*The petitioner shall comply with the conditions enumerated under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. failing which he shall not be entitled to the protection of interim bail allowed to him.”*

Upon instructions from ASI Sahib Singh, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the aforesaid orders, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 10.01.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
