There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction to the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioner and his family, which is in danger at the hands of private respondents.

A perusal of the representation dated 15.09.2022 (Annexure P-3), and the pleadings of the present petition are not sufficient to impress this Court as to what kind of threat perception, petitioner and his family members are facing. It seems that the petition has been filed merely due to some personal grudges on account of some dispute with regard to the payment of cheque amount pertaining to the sale and purchase of a vehicle.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is at liberty to take appropriate action in accordance with law. This petition deserves to be dismissed having no merits.
