Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had applied for the grant of child care leave for a period of 224 days and by an interim order dated 05.07.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the said benefit was granted but, the respondents have granted the petitioner benefit of child care leave for a period of three months only, which is not only contrary to the order passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court but, is also illegal and arbitrary.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner also intends to avail the remaining child care leave and respondents may kindly be directed to consider her claim.

Learned State counsel submits that in case the petitioner intends to avail the remaining child care leave available in her credit, let the petitioner apply for the same and an appropriate order on the request of the

petitioner will be passed by the respondents in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the said request of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed off having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
