The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

While issuing, notice of motion on 16.12.2021, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner is not being allowed to participate in stage 2 of the selection process for the post of Constable on account of alleged discrepancy in the bio-metrics which according to learned counsel for the petitioner is on account of error in the software/data mismatch. Learned counsel contends that in the circumstances the petitioner cannot be prejudiced for the fault of others.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ayush Sarna, AAG, Punjab accepts notice and requests for time to obtain instructions.

Adjourned to 10.01.2022.

In the meantime, the petitioner is allowed to participate in stage 2 of the selection process purely on provisional basis subject to the outcome of the writ petition. However, the result of the petitioner shall not be declared without the permission of the Court.

Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, DAG, Punjab, enters appearance

on behalf of State of Punjab and on instructions from Sh.Prabhash Gaur, TCS, Dy.Zonal Manager, states that the petitioner was permitted to participate in the selection process on provisional basis, however, he has failed in the physical measurement test.

In view thereof, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
