Lawyers are abstaining from work today, therefore, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners.

This is a petition filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions/orders/instructions to the respondents for conducting fair and impartial investigation and for deciding the representations (Annexures P-1 and P-2), wherein the allegations with regard to threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners has been raised, on account of earlier litigation, wherein accused Rachhpal Singh stands convicted in FIR No.51, dated 07.06.2009, under Sections 302/120-B, registered at Police Station Jaitu and sentenced for life and in another case, he was sentenced for 10 years, under Section 307 of the IPC.

The petitioners have raised the grievance in the present petition on account of the fact that accused Rachhpal Singh is out on parole and causing threat to the life and liberty and not allowing them to carry out

agricultural work. The representations dated 19.06.2021 (Annexure P-1) and 18.05.2022 (Annexure P-2), in this behalf have also been made to the I.G. (Jails), Punjab and to Deputy Commissioner, Faridkot, respectively.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to consider and decide the representations dated 19.06.2021 (Annexure P-1) and 18.05.2022 (Annexure P-2), in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
