Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.189 dated 28.06.2020 under Sections 307, 341, 325, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner has been attributed injury with a wooden bat on the left leg and shoulder of the complainant. The injury which attracted Section 307 IPC had been attributed to co-accused Happy Singh. He points out that the petitioner is in custody since 15.08.2020 and the trial has not made much progress.

witnesses, only 01 witness has been examined. He, however, does not controvert the fact that the injury which attracted Section 307 IPC is attributed to the petitioner and co-accused Happy Singh.

Considering the submissions made by the parties and without commenting on the merits of the case, lest it may prejudice the outcome of the trial and also considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 15.08.2020 (i.e. more than 01 year and 06 months) and the petitioner is not author of the fatal blow, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The observations made here-in-above shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the trial Court shall decide the case on the basis of available material.
