Through this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.202 dated 19.06.2017, registered under Sections 323, 341, 427, 506, 148, 149, 452 and 380 IPC, at Police Station Focal Point, District Ludhiana.

At this stage, Mr. J.S. Grewal, Advocate appears and files memorandum of appearance on behalf of the petitioners in the Court, which is taken on record.

Vide order dated 10.01.2020 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for amicable settlement between the parties.

As per the report dated 04.03.2020 of the Mediator, joint and separate sessions of the parties were held on 21.01.2020, 29.01.2020,

10.02.2020, 25.02.2020 and 04.03.2020, but despite best efforts the parties could not reach at any settlement.

Learned State counsel points out that petitioner No.1 died on 24.04.2020.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the documents on record.

The matter was relegated to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for amicable settlement between the parties, but as the same could not be materialised despite best efforts.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
