The instant petition had been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of order dated 20.04.2017, whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed person in FIR No.98 dated 20.08.2013 under Sections 419, 420, 424, 465, 467, 468, 471, 477-A and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Mehtapur, Tehsil Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner points out that pursuant to the interim order dated 17.03.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been admitted to interim bail. He submits that the petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court on all subsequent dates of hearing unless exempted by the trial Court.

In view of this, the interim order dated 17.03.2022 is made absolute.
