AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This petition was filed for quashing of order dated 3rd July, 2019, whereby the petitioner was declared 'proclaimed offender' in case of FIR No. 145, dated 12th September, 2015, under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the Act') registered at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur.
2. Notice of motion was issued on 1st October, 2019 and petitioner was directed to join proceedings before the trial Court and she was ordered to be released on interim bail till the next date of hearing.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar submits that petitioner had joined the investigation and by order dated 17th March, 2021 was convicted for fifteen days with a fine of Rs.1000/-.
4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.

5. However, in case of a factual discrepancy in the statement made by learned State counsel, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for recalling of the order.
